Any adult that has an NRA or CMP classification of Expert (EX) or lower, including those with no classification or with no prior competition experience at all

What to bring:

Rifles, ammunition, and equipment will be made available to every shooter, with priority given to junior shooters. All participants are welcome to bring their own rifle, ammunition, and equipment as long as it is in safe working order and meets the safety requirements of Milan Rifle Club 200 yard range (e.g. no steel core ammunition)

Course of Fire: **All courses will be at the 200 yard line using the SR-1 target**

Prone Slow-fire

3 minutes preparation

2 sighting shots slow-fire and 10 shots slow-fire for record in 12 minutes

Prone Rapid-fire

3 minutes preparation

2 sighting shots slow-fire in 2 minutes

10 shots rapid-fire, with magazine change, for record in 70 seconds

Sitting Rapid-fire

3 minutes preparation

2 sighting shots slow-fire in 2 minutes

10 shots rapid-fire, with magazine change, for record in 60 seconds

Offhand Slow-fire

3 minutes preparation

2 sighting shots slow-fire and 10 shots slow-fire for record in 12 minutes
